## Top 10 home safety tips

Install & inspect smoke and Co2 alarms

> Replace door knobs with level style handles

Ensure all railings are sturdy

> Pad sharp edges with bumpers

Install auto shut offs on kitchen appliances

Install grab bars

Shower bench

Install ramps over stairways or consider a stair lift

Remove all trip hazards: rugs, thresholds, clutter, etc.

lighting in hallways and entryways

- 1. Emergency call numbers handy
- 2. Someone to check in with you regularly
- 3. Find a handyman you can trust
- 4. Never provide your personal information to someone who calls you on the phone
- 5. Secure your valuables
- 6. Maintain a first aid kit within easy reach
- 7. Ensure all medications are properly labeled and not expired
- 8. Exercise regularly and watch your diet
- 9. Consider a cordless or cellular phone
- 10. Have a plan in case of emergencies

#### **Personal Emergency Response Systems**

- Key features to look for:
  - Auto Alert: Will the PERS detect a fall and automatically set itself off should the user be unconscious
  - It is waterproof and can be worn in the shower
  - It has a service program: replacement parts, batteries and the unit itself can be serviced or replaced at no or low cost
  - It has no contract: you can stop at anytime with no cost incurred



### **Passive Monitoring Technology**

- These require nothing of the user and blend in with the background
  - Medication dispensing
  - Food intake
  - Location
  - Other ancillary information
- Information can be accessed by family/caregivers
- Have alerting thresholds
- Are monitored by clinicians



### **Home Health Monitoring**

- Telehealth
  - Clinical monitoring
  - For vulnerable clients
  - Monitors BP, pulse, & weight
  - Facetime for client and nurse
- Helps us monitor vitals and intercede before a crisis
- This is more involved and requires active participation of the user. It is not passive.



#### **GPS**

- GPS Solutions
  - Commercially available devices
  - Cell phones
  - Cars
- Features to look for
  - Geofencing
  - Audible beacon
  - Easy applications/interfacing
